Stage I breast cancer is divided into two parts, A and B: Stage 1A breast cancer: The tumor is 2 cm or smaller and has not spread to the lymph nodes. Stage 1B breast cancer: Small microscopic breast cancer cells are either found in the lymph nodes close to the breast and either no tumor is found in the breast or the tumor is smaller than 2 cm.
