Reports from human rights NGOs say that within the Yemen war there have been at least seven areas in which international law has been seriously violated, including: unlawful airstrikes, use of landmines, use of cluster munitions, violations of women and girls ' rights, the use of child soldiers, the blocking of humanitarian aid including medical assistance, terrorism, torture and arbitrary detention.
