The introduction paragraph ends with your thesis statement, which identifies whether your expectations were met and what you learned. The thesis statement serves as the focal point of your paper.

Format the reflection paper the same way you would any other APA essay. It should be double spaced, with the title in a header in all caps at the top left of each page and the page number at the top right. Include a title page with the title, your name, and any other required information (like the name of your class or school).

Write an introduction for your paper. The introduction should include a summary of the speech, film or incident you are reflecting on. Your final sentence--the thesis statement--should give an overview of your thoughts. Write a conclusion for your paper.
