More particularly, CIIMT studies managerial questions regarding strategic trade control of military and dual-use goods and services. CIIMT ties in with the Netherlands Defence Academy's vision on scientific education, embedded in the reflective practitioners' paradigm uniting both management and leadership skills needed to decide and operate in high-tension and high-risk knowledge intensive environments. The Faculty of Military Sciences uses the reflective practitioners' paradigm to refer to critical thinking, reflection and Bildung that characterize its thinking doers, the so-called Thinking Soldiers, either at the academic Bachelor's or Master's level. In view of the complexity of

the international trade regarding military and dual-use goods and services, the rapid evolvement of strategic trade control and frameworks, and its importance to procurement processes, defence organizations require innovative thinking doers, who, based on an indepth understanding, from an interdisciplinary perspective can be expected to find - and take responsibility for - creative solutions to problems. NL ARMS 2021 comprises, amongst others, contributions from students and lecturers partaking in this programme. All the editors are affiliated with the Faculty of Military Sciences of the Netherlands Defence Academy in Breda, The Netherlands.

The integrity of knowledge that emerges from research is based on individual and collective adherence to core values of objectivity, honesty, openness, fairness, accountability, and stewardship. Integrity in science means that the organizations in which research is conducted encourage those involved to exemplify these values in every step of the research process. Understanding the dynamics that support \hat{a} €" or distort \hat{a} €" practices that uphold the integrity of research by all participants ensures that the research enterprise advances knowledge. The 1992 report Responsible Science: Ensuring the Integrity of the Research Process evaluated issues related to scientific responsibility and the conduct of research. It provided a valuable service in describing and analyzing a very complicated set of issues, and has served as a crucial basis for thinking about research integrity for more than two decades. However, as experience has accumulated with various forms of research misconduct, detrimental research practices, and other forms of misconduct, as subsequent empirical research has revealed more about the nature of scientific misconduct, and because technological and social changes have altered the environment in which science is conducted, it is clear that the framework established more than two decades ago needs to be updated. Responsible Science served as a valuable benchmark to set the context for this most recent analysis and to help quide the committee's thought process. Fostering Integrity in Research identifies best practices in research and recommends practical options for discouraging and addressing research misconduct and detrimental research practices.

This research and policy book examines the role of women in the military and the overwhelming evidence to date that warranted repealing the combat exclusion policy. Accountability, the heart of military leadership, is closely related to ethics, integrity, morality, and responsibility. This research paper first examines these relationships and illustrates some of the unique qualities of accountability which set it apart as the most critical element of leadership. Next is a discussion of where and to whom leaders are accountable, followed by an historical glimpse at military leaders and how their successes and failures were reflections of their accountability. The concluding section of this paper is a compilation of interviews with contemporary military leaders presenting their views regarding the urgency of accountability.

Artificial intelligence (AI) is a rapidly growing field of technology with potentially significantimplications for national security. As such, the U.S. Department of Defense (DOD) and othernations are developing AI applications for a range of military functions. AI research is underwayin the fields of intelligence collection and analysis, logistics, cyber operations, informationoperations, command and control, and in a variety of semiautonomous and autonomous vehicles. Already, AI has been incorporated into military operations in Iraq and Syria. Congressional actionhas the potential to shape the technology's development further, with budgetary and legislativedecisions influencing the growth of military applications as well as the pace of their adoption.AI technologies present unique challenges for military integration, particularly because the bulkof AI development is happening in the commercial sector. Although AI is not unique in this regard, the defense acquisition process may need to be adapted for acquiring emergingtechnologies like AI. In addition, many commercial AI applications must undergo significant modification prior to being functional for the military. A number of cultural issues also challengeAI acquisition, as some commercial AI companies are averse to partnering with DOD due toethical concerns, and even within the department, there can be resistance to incorporating Altechnology into existing weapons systems and processes. Potential international rivals in the AI market are creating pressure for the United States tocompete for innovative military AI applications. China is a leading competitor in this regard, releasing a plan in 2017 to capture the global lead in AI development by 2030. Currently, China isprimarily focused on using AI to make faster and more well-informed decisions, as well as ondeveloping a variety of autonomous military vehicles. Russia is also active in military Aldevelopment, with a primary focus on robotics. Although AI has the potential to impart a number of advantages in the military context, it mayalso introduce distinct challenges. AI technology could, for example, facilitate autonomousoperations, lead to more informed military decisionmaking, and increase the speed and scale ofmilitary action. However, it may

also be unpredictable or vulnerable to unique forms ofmanipulation. As a result of these factors, analysts hold a broad range of opinions on howinfluential AI will be in future combat operations
